### ST VINCENT DE PAUL WINTER APPEAL

Thank you and well done to the people who make up the Parish of St Bridgets. Your generosity and support meant that we took two van loads and three private car loads of bedding, towels, clothing and food to the Half Moon caravan park in Brooklyn this week. In addition we raised \$3,294 in direct financial donations. Thank you also to the 21 volunteers who stayed behind after mass to help sort and load the goods. In addition to the relief and physical comfort brought by these gifts, we bring the knowledge that literally hundreds of people from St Bridgets chose to put their faith into action and share their possessions with strangers in need. These gifts and the sense of caring make an immediate and positive improvement to their conditions.

### ST BRIDGETS SUPPORTS CAMCARE

Camcare is an organisation that supports needy people with a variety of free services ranging from Counselling and Tax Help to provision of emergency food relief. Located in building at the rear of the Camberwell shopping centre it is readily accessible. People in genuine need may call in 9 am to 4.30 pm Mon-Fri and be given emergency food relief in the form of food vouchers, bread (donated by the Union Rd Bakery) fruit and vegetables (donated by Second Bite) and non perishable food items donated by individuals, businesses and Churches. St Bridget's parish council has endorsed this project and there is a box in the narthex for donation of food items. Each week donated items will be taken to Camcare for distribution. This programme is additional to the work of the St Vincent De Paul Society and there is no duplication. If you can spare a few items such as tinned food, packets of dry food, pasta, etc please place them in the box provided.
