ST VINCENT DE PAUL WINTER APPEAL

The caravan park, which we particularly support, has specifically requested these items. In recent years, this parish's Conference of St Vincent De Paul has supported the Half Moon caravan park in Brooklyn. This caravan park is used as short-term crisis accommodation for people in dire circumstances, and although they do an amazing job to provide shelter, it is a pretty grim place to be living for months at a time. In the past, the caravan park has been used for interim accommodation for mothers and children, but at the moment it also houses a larger number of single men. Any donations of blankets, doona's, towels, non-perishable food and money will be taken directly to the caravan park by us for distribution by the RDNS Sister.
