DIOCESAN SOCIAL PROFILE

From the 2021 Australian Census

The Australian Catholic Bishops Conference has issued diocesan profiles derived from the 2021 Census. Over the next few weeks we will publish some details from the Melbourne profile.

- Catholic population: 1,038,276 [The largest Catholic diocese in Australia. Brisbane is the second-largest with 684,423 Catholics].
- Catholics make up 20.9% of the population.
- The median age for Catholics is 43 years.

- 331,471 Catholics were born overseas. The five largest groups are:

Italy	4.8%
Philippines	3.9%
India	2.0%
U.K.	1.8%
Vietnam	1.7%
- In the last five years, the largest groups of Catholics arriving in Melbourne are from: Colombia, Brazil, Iraq, Philippines and Indonesia.
