The Australian Catholic Bishops Conference has issued diocesan profiles derived from the 2021 Census. Over the next few weeks we will publish some details from the Melbourne profile.

- Catholic population: 1,038,276
 [The largest Catholic diocese in Australia.
 Brisbane is the second-largest with
 684,423 Catholics].
- Catholics make up 20.9% of the population.
- The median age for Catholics is 43 years.

• 331,471 Catholics were born overseas.

The five largest groups are:

Italy 4.8%
Philippines 3.9%
India 2.0%
U.K. 1.8%
Vietnam 1.7%

 In the last five years, the largest groups of Catholics arriving in Melbourne are from: Colombia, Brazil, Iraq, Philippines

and Indonesia.


