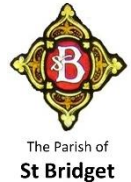

ANNUAL PARISH CHILD SAFETY REPORT

- There have been no incidents reported in our Affiliated Parishes over the past year.
- We are continuing to monitor possible risks.
- The Safeguarding Committee has held three meetings so far this year, and the next meeting will be with the Eastern Region Professional Safeguarding Unit Officer from CAM to submit our Safeguarding Assessment document, which is submitted annually.
- Child Safety training is required to be undertaken annually by all Clergy, Staff and Volunteers.
- All volunteers must hold a current Working with Children Check.
